# Super Slot Car Night

Thanks to all who volunteered and participated in Chesapeake Region's annual Super Slot Car Night at the Parkville Family Y. Many thanks to David Dukehart and Cheryl Taylor for securing a very nice venue for our races this year. We had 39 adults and 13 children participate in this classic, mid-winter family Porsche event. Unfortunately, we missed a number of our regular competitors who were attending National PCA meetings in Florida. Nevertheless, we had plenty of competition. A special thanks to Michael Cook, Cheryl and Claude Taylor, Steve Kubisen, Lee Raskin, Lori Williams, and others who volunteered to help set up the track, tables, chairs, and the various food items. It appears that we had even more folks chipping in to breakdown the room in the end.

Participants sampled some unique pots of tasty chili this year. Racers and their families sampled from pots of Chocolate Turkey Chili - Low Sodium with Organic Beans, Beef Chili, Turkey Chili - Low Sodium and Chocolate Turkey Chili. Monica Areford's Chocolate Turkey Chili ultimately took the top prize in a very close competition.

It took a team of seven "wanna be" electrical engineers and one actual electrician to get the track set up and chase the ever present gremlins away. This year was a little more challenging because for the first time, the track was set up to mimic the Baltimore Grand Prix course rather than the Summit Point course.

The juniors led off the race events with nine kids participating in the races. We saw some fierce racing between the youngsters this year with a couple of returning winners from last year. Our juniors heat winners were Tyler and Zachary, while the Junior Enduro team winners consisted of Tyler, Gregory, Zachary, and Sebastian. Zachary held off the competition in the end to win the junior championship. This was clearly a night where all the kids were winners, and each received a trophy for participating.

The adult races were filled with some very aggressive driving and plenty of crash and burn accidents. However, the most challenging part of slot car racing is just keeping your car on the track. Those cars leaving the track in the adult races were disqualified. It takes lots of competitiveness, patience, and skill to win in these races. Ultimately, the heat winners were Kathy Ricketson, Brian Funk, Cheryl Taylor, Terrell Williams, and Lori Williams. In the end, Terrell Williams grabbed this year's adult championship - by default after all of his competitors flamed out.

The adult's enduro race was marked by Team Chesapeake's rear wheel sheering off around lap 32 of 40. Someone claimed to have seen this happen on an Audi before, but never on a Porsche! We told you the racing was fierce. Members of Team Guinness, Mike Cook, Kathy Ricketson, Sean Ricketson, and Kathy Hupfeldt, ultimately outlasted the competition to claim the adult enduro title.

By the way, there are whispers of taking our Chesapeake PCA track to Baltimore Grand Prix officials as a potential corporate event. Stay tuned for more opportunities to participate in super slot car racing this year.







# The Mart

## 1972 911T

Consider yourself driving a Porsche from a great era. The looks, handling, performance from the new engine increase to 2.4 L for 1972 took the early 911's to a new level. This 1972 Guards Red 911T was engine upgraded to "E" spec. w/911S trim and black RECARO Sport seats wich hold firmly. Many upgrades such as H-4's, Turbo tie rods, Turbo valve covers, and Carrera chain tensioners compliment the strong engine. The 915 gearbox has a short shift; Targa top re-skinned. Having had class wins in coucours it has been always garaged and no winters. Two AGM batteries always charged with battery tender. A vintage 911 wood steering wheel is optional.
